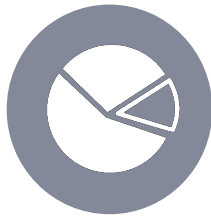
Opportunistic

While providing the best Australian-based opportunities, the Fund considers its investments in a global context. With access to PM Capital's effective international research, the Fund can invest 0-20% in companies internationally if they provide better risk/ reward propositions than are present domestically.
